DID YOU KNOW?

Even a slight hearing loss may affect your ability to communicate with people.

We recommend having a diagnostic hearing evaluation every 2 years after the age of 45, or sooner if there is a family history of hearing loss or a medical condition such as diabetes, heart disease, or if you are taking medications that cause hearing loss or ringing in the ears.

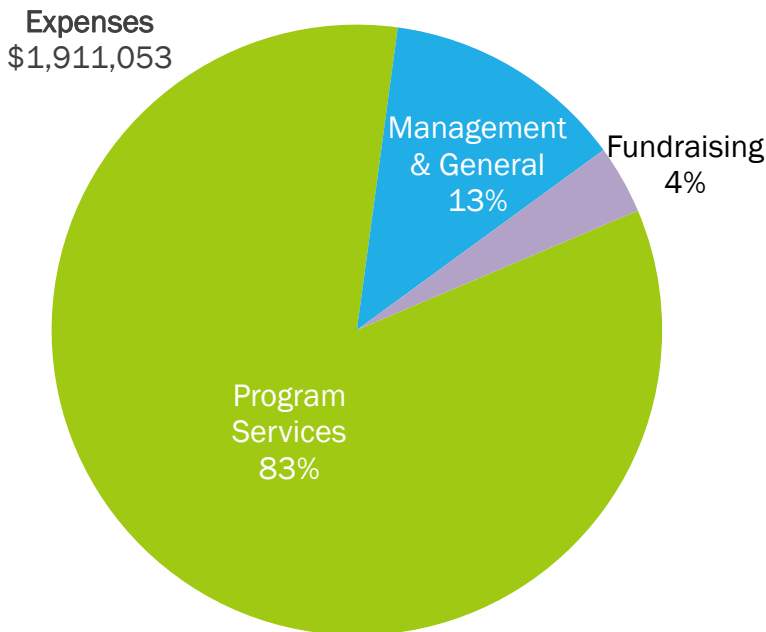
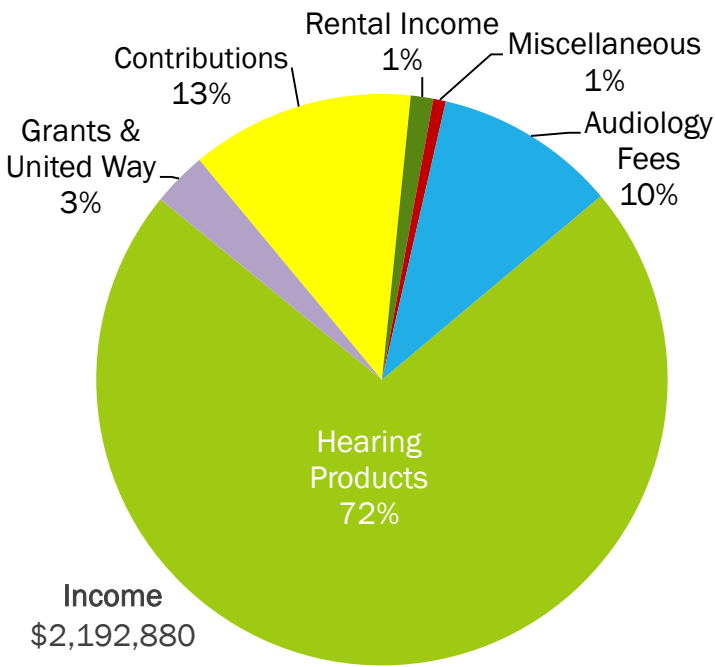
Even the best hearing aids may not be enough to hear the way you'd like to in more challenging listening situations.

When your needs are beyond what your hearing aids are capable of handling, then your audiologist may recommend accessories that work with your hearing aids to enhance your listening experience.

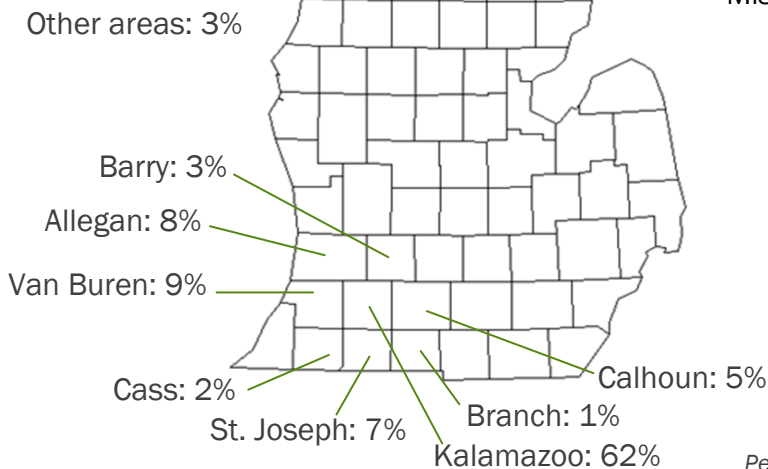

(1,142 new patients)

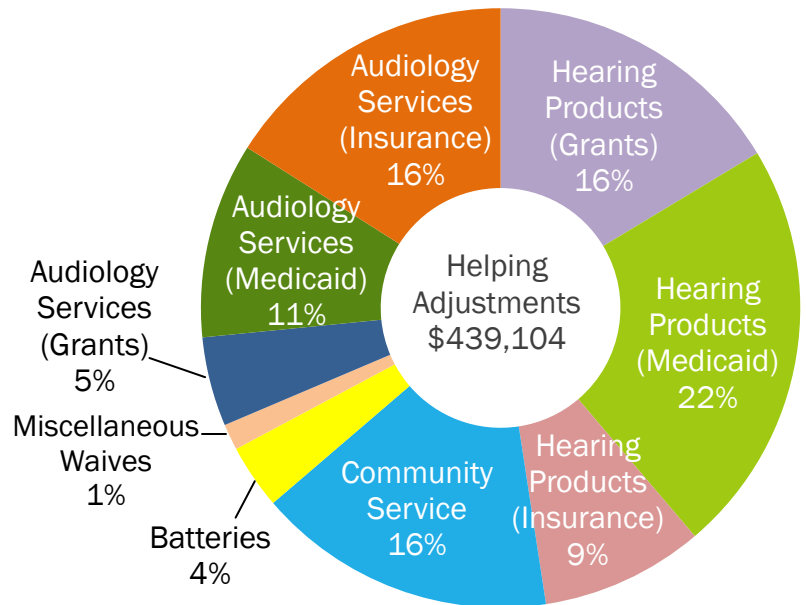
- 312 children, ages 0-5

A sliding fee scale is offered to patients who cannot afford the full cost of services. In 2017, such helping adjustments totaled \$439,104
